PARENT'S PROBLEM-SOLVING PROTOCOL

Most problems that arise can be resolved by establishing two-way communication with the coach. Parents should follow these steps when addressing concerns:

1. Contact the **coach** about concerns
2. If not satisfied, contact the **site Athletic Director**
3. If not satisfied, contact the **site Principal**



PARENTS and STUDENTS

Must know and weigh the risks involved in athletics before involving their child in sports.

HEAT ILLNESS:

Prevention involves regular hydration; once thirsty, it's too late.

- Athlete should be drinking throughout the day.
- Important that athlete has proper acclimation during preseason training.
- Critical that athletes report any signs of sickness to coach.



Helpful Information:

- Athletes must ride the bus to away games
- At away games, **ONLY** a parent may transport their student home. The coach must be notified, in person, that the student will leave with the parent. *Written permission must be provided for someone other than a parent to pick-up a student.*
- Athletes must be picked-up at BJHS within 15 minutes of the end of a game or practice.



UNIFORMS AND EQUIPMENT

- Ensure that school-issued uniforms and equipment are cared for during the season.
- Ensure that school-issued uniforms and equipment are turned in after the last game.
- Athletes are financially responsible for lost/damaged uniforms.
