Bogle athletic teams participate as members of the East Valley Athletic conference, which includes all CUSD junior highs and Queen Creek's Newell Barney Middle School. A comprehensive sports menu is offered during four competitive seasons that coincide with the quarterly grading periods:

Student-athletes are held to high standards for academic and behavioral standards because of the high profile they maintain on our campus. It is considered a privilege to participate on an athletic team. We are a "Victory With Honor" school and emphasize character development through athletics. At Bogle, a one-week tryout period precedes the selection of team members. All prospective athletes **must have** a completed eligibility packet turned in to the Student Services Clerk **prior** to the first day of practice to be cleared for tryouts. **The physical evaluation must be completed on the district form.** This is a district requirement to insure the safety of students and reduce liability issues for BJHS and CUSD. Any physical dated after **March 1st** is valid for the next academic school year. Also, athletes are **required to have health insurance coverage.** School accident insurance is available through Myers-Stevens if needed. In order for BJHS to take advantage of the Arizona state tax credit program that supports extra-curricular activities, CUSD has implemented a yearly fee of \$1.00 per family for participation in after-school activities. Bogle also gratefully accepts any tax credit donations up to \$400 per family.
